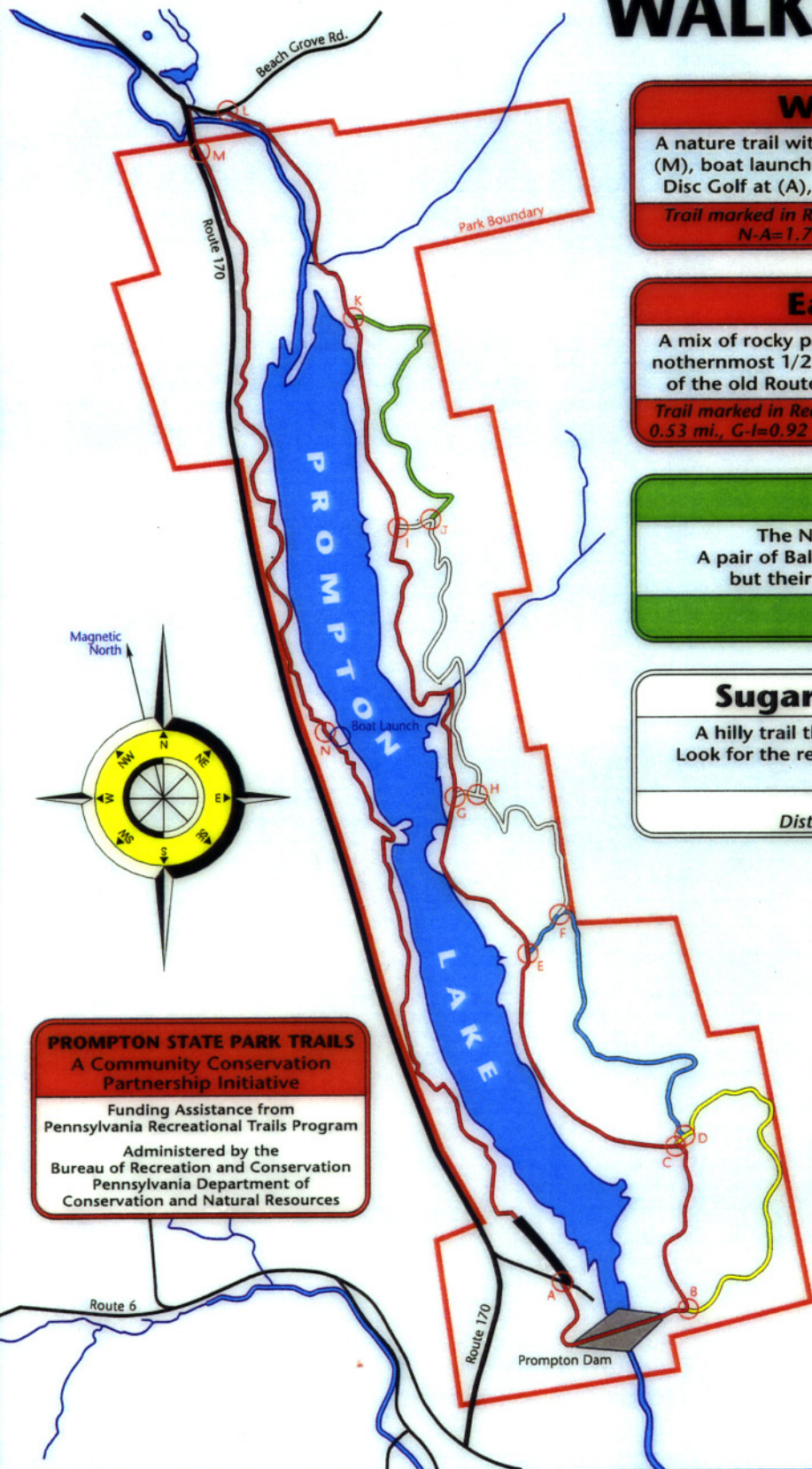


# PROMPTON STATE PARK

**West Shore Trail**

A nature trail with some extras: a radio-control airfield at (M), boat launching at (N), main parking, picnic area and Disc Golf at (A), and portable restrooms at (N) and (A).

*Trail marked in Red; Distance L-M=0.24 mi., M-N=1.75 mi., N-A=1.79 mi., A-B=0.51 mi. Total 4.29 mi.*

**East Shore Trail**

A mix of rocky paths and smooth forest floor, except the northernmost 1/2 mile (near point L) which is the remains of the old Route 170 before it was flooded by the dam.

*Trail marked in Red; Distance B-C=1.07 mi., C-E=0.75 mi., E-G=0.53 mi., G-I=0.92 mi., I-K=0.58 mi., K-L=0.69 mi. Total 4.54 mi.*

**Eagle Pass**

The Northernmost loop in the park.  
 A pair of Bald Eagles have been seen in the area, but their nesting site has not been found.

*Trail marked in Green  
 Distance J-K=0.87 mi.*

**Sugar Shack Trail North**

A hilly trail that winds through forests and fields. Look for the remnants of a maple sugaring operation off in the woods.

*Trail marked in White  
 Distance H-J=1.02 mi., J-I=0.1 mi.*

**Sugar Shack South**

More forests and fields.  
 Point H is the mid-point of the trail.

*Trail marked in White  
 Distance F-H=0.59 mi., H-G=0.07 mi.*

**High Ledge Trail**

This trail runs along the top of some sheer rock faces, overlooking the East Shore Trail and Prompton Lake.

*Trail marked in Blue  
 Distance D-F=0.83 mi., F-E=0.25 mi.*

**Hemlock Trail**

Most of the trail winds through mixed forest, with a stand of old-growth Hickory near the North end.

*Trail marked in Yellow  
 Distance B-D=1.04 mi., D-C=0.03 mi.*
